



# SCHOOL DAY RULES AND REGULATIONS

These rules make life easier for ALL of us!  
Thank you!

Chaperones MUST read over WITH  
students BEFORE attending the Faire!

May arrive as early as 9:00 a.m.,  
Gates open at 9:30 a.m.

## BEFORE YOU JOIN US

### NAME TAGS REQUIRED

For identification, all students are required to wear a nametag, complete with the school's name and the student's name.

### NO BACKPACKS

ONLY clear one gallon bags or bags smaller than 12"x12"x6" are permitted into the venue. **No backpacks or tote bags** are allowed to be carried by students on the Faire site. A chaperone may carry one bag with the essentials for a group. All bags are subject to inspection by RPF personnel prior to entering or exiting the gates.

### ASSIGN CHAPERONES

Students must be divided into groups to avoid traffic flow problems and ensure proper supervision. Elementary students must be divided into groups of 6 and high school students must be divided into groups of 10. There must be one adult chaperone with each group at all times. Please see EXIT PROCEDURE for further instruction.

### SCHOOL DAY TICKETS ONLY

You MUST have a School Day ticket for admission. No regular Faire admission tickets, coupons or weekend promotional tickets will be accepted on School Day. The general public is not admitted on School Day. (Likewise, FYI, School Day tickets may NOT be used on any other Faire day.)



### NO WEAPONS

No weapons of any kind are allowed on the Faire site. Wooden weapons purchased inside Faire are NOT to be played with in the exit area AT ALL. If a student needs to be told a second time to keep the weapon down, that will be confiscated. PERIOD. These are weapons. They can cause serious injury.

### FOOD

The Faire offers a variety of tasty food including vegetarian and gluten-free options. Menu prices start at \$1. Though the Faire DOES NOT ALLOW OUTSIDE FOOD AND BEVERAGE INSIDE THE MAIN GATES, you may bring your own lunch if you leave it in your vehicle/bus. There are picnic tables a short walking distance from the Faire's entrance. One bottled water may be brought into the Faire.

## DAY OF EVENT DETAILS

### NEW! PARKING PASS TO ATTENDANT

Driver must hand pre-purchased pass to attendant for parking. All others must purchase parking upon arrival, \$30 per bus or \$10 per vehicle; cash only.

### PASS OUT TICKETS

EACH person must have a ticket. Gate personnel will take one ticket at a time from each person for admission. It is best to pass out tickets just prior to arrival to prevent loss. EACH person going through the gate MUST have a ticket in hand. The lines and/or groups can become mixed up and it is IMPOSSIBLE to know which students go with which set of tickets from each chaperone. The gatekeeper will NOT take a handful of tickets from one person and then attempt to count in that many students.

### EXIT PROCEDURE FOR GROUPS (END OF DAY OR LUNCH)"

Meet your group(s) at your assigned exit point. Use assigned chaperone to lead his/her group to proceed to the exit area together; at which point each chaperone will account for each student in his/her group leaving the Faire. Again, no student will exit without a chaperone.

Once your entire group is together, a chaperone is to come to the exit ONLY when they have all their students gathered. At that time, the chaperone will come forward (ahead of the students) and acknowledge EACH student as they pass by them through the exit. Each student MUST be acknowledged by a chaperone in order to exit.

### NEW! GROUP(S) ARRIVING SEPARATELY?

If not shipped to you, pick up tickets from Will Call. Person with tickets will go to the School Meet Up tables. In advance, prep two printed signs with the School's name (disposable paper signs are just fine). You will display one sign behind the contact person standing at the table (on the fence line) as well as one on a stanchion post (at the start of the school's student line). You will find these tables set up to the right (when facing entrance) of the front gate to meet with people in your group as they arrive to give them tickets. This will be away from box office and gate entrance congestion.

### GUEST RELATIONS BOOTH

Our Guest Relations booth may be found at the top of our Food Court. Lost children and items will be brought here.

### AUTOGRAPHS

Please do not allow your students to ask for autographs from the performers. Unfortunately, this prevents the performers from being able to interact with all students.

### SHOPLIFTING

Anyone found shoplifting or damaging Faire property will be prosecuted! These are serious offenses and will not be tolerated.



## SHOW ETIQUETTE

It is imperative that everyone observes the following rules and regulations while watching shows and demonstrations. This is the only way to ensure that everyone can hear the performers and enjoy the show. PLEASE GO OVER THESE RULES WITH YOUR STUDENTS!

- Give your full attention to the show you are watching. Do not talk with your friends.
- Treat performers with the courtesy and respect that you would want them to treat you.
- Do not throw anything at performers on Faire property. Security will escort violators off site.
